Dear Cllr Dowling,

Thank you for your letter of 29 January 2014.

Having now received details of the Council Tax Referendum Limits and Exceptions to the excessiveness principle, I have decided to set the Band D equivalent for Sussex Police at £141.12 an increase of £2.70 (1.95%) over the current level of £138.42.

With a tax base of 571,655.38 this will produce precept income of £80,672,007.23 in 2014/15.

Listed below is what this will mean for each council tax band:

Band A	£94.08	£1.80
Band B	£109.76	£2.10
Band C	£125.44	£2.40
Band D	£141.12	£2.70
Band E	£172.48	£3.30
Band F	£203.84	£3.90
Band G	£235.20	£4.50
Band H	£282.24	£5.40

This level of increase is of course within the limit supported by the Police & Crime Panel on 24 January 2014 and I would be grateful if you would formally confirm the Panel's continuing support for my decision.
