**It is important that all participants acknowledge the below 5 statements before proceeding further.**

- The Restorative Justice (RJ) process has been explained to me, my involvement is voluntary and I can withdraw at any time.
  
- My details and case information will be passed to relevant agencies within the Sussex RJ Partnership. The Partnership may contact other agencies with which I have had previous links, or with which I may have links in the future, to obtain or share information about me, including details of any previous convictions.
  
- I understand the Sussex RJ Partnership will retain records in line with the agreed Information Sharing Agreement (ISA). I understand I am entitled to request sight of the ISA and any documents. Any information exchanged under the agreement will only be used for the purpose of delivering RJ. In exceptional circumstances, information may be shared without my express permission if it could help to prevent a crime or harm to any person.
  
- I understand it is common practice for an independent observer to sit in on the RJ conference and understand they are there for training and development purposes.
  
- Occasionally research related to RJ work takes place and I consent to share my personal contact details with researchers including my name, date of birth, gender and ethnicity and have further communication with them after the process to respond to research questions.
