Summary of reasons for decision	<p>On 29 January 2021 the Sussex Police and Crime Panel supported the proposal of the Sussex Police and Crime Commissioner (the PCC) to issue a band D council tax precept for the Sussex area of £214.91.</p> <p>There are statutory requirements for the PCC to calculate the budget requirements and formally issue a precept for the financial year.</p>
