



## 2021/2022 Financial Year

### The purpose of the grant:

The Commissioner may make community safety grants to any person or organisation. These are grants which, in the opinion of the Commissioner, will secure, or contribute to securing, crime and disorder reduction in Sussex.

The 'Safer in Sussex' Community Safety Fund (CSF) provides financial support to local projects that tackle crime, reduce reoffending and improve community safety.

### Conditions attached the grant:

Each application was assessed against the Fund criteria and the ability of the project to actively and directly address the priorities in the Commissioner's Police & Crime Plan. The Terms and Conditions of the grant are set out on the funding application form.

Total CSF allocated in the first tranche (2021/2022 September 2021): £104,711.58

Total CSF allocated in the Second tranche (2021/2022 February 2022): £76,673
