

**The purpose of the grant:**

The Commissioner may make community safety grants to any person or organisation. These are grants which, in the opinion of the Commissioner, will secure, or contribute to securing, crime and disorder reduction in Sussex.

The 'Safer in Sussex' Community Safety Fund (CSF) provides financial support to local projects that tackle crime, reduce reoffending and improve community safety.
